We are so blessed by you all and we are always so encouraged that people are still so invested in this journey of ours.

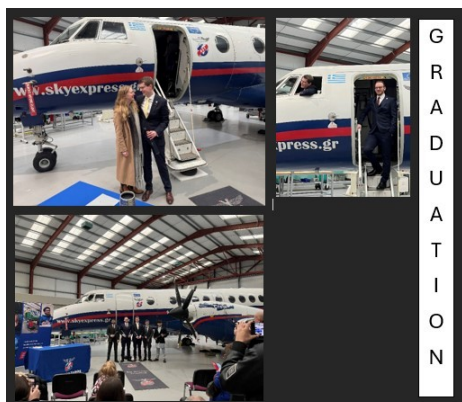

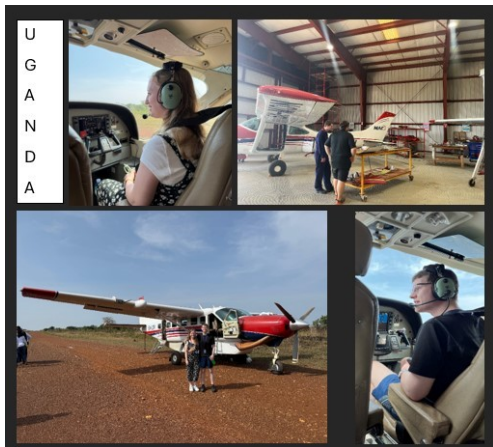
